Steps for Surgical Practices

- 1. We should sit and discuss with the patient. We should sensitize the patient and relatives about the probable outcome of the treatment. They should be made to understand that we offer the best treatment but the outcome is not in our hands.
- 2. At the same time, we should not take everything granted. Surgeons should be sensitized about the importance of documentation detailing the discussion with the patient and relatives.
- 3.In the current era of knowledge explosion the social media should be sensitized about these issues so that there is no misinterpretation and propagation of false and unauthenticated information in the media. We should have cordial relationship with media.
- 4. Scientific body like ASI should have the CONSTITUTIONAL SUPPORT. We should make all attempts to bring the change in the constitution. Like the quota in Rajya sabha for eminent personalities, our scientific body should have representation in legislative councils and Rajya sabha. This will help in making our voice heard loud in state assemblies and parliment.

Association of India With Advisory Role in Constitutional and Administrative Bodies

The constitutional and administrative bodies often pass various draconian directives which hamper our surgical practice. They do not understand the ground realities and gravity of problems and pass the directives and decisions arrived unilaterally. Our real voices of dissent and unheard. To cite a few, GST counsil, Pollution control board, electricity board, local bodies like corporation, judiciary etc often pass various laws and directives which are not conducive in day to day practice.



Under the auspices of Association of Surgeons of India Tamil Nadu Chapter, we conducted the Monthly CME meet on "Robotics in GI Surgery" and "Recent Advances in Breast Cancer Management" for all the surgical faculty. The meeting was well attended by 51 members [32 Practicing Surgeons and 19 Post Graduates]

TNASI Midasicon Conference 2024 at Kumbakonam

The Midasicon Conference 2024, organized by the Kumbakonam branch of the Tamil Nadu chapter of the ASI, convened at the Hotel Quality InnViha in Kumbakonam on March 10th, 2024. The conference organizing committee consisted of the following individuals: Dr. Prabhakar U, MS, MCh, served as the Organizing Chairman; Dr. Bharathidhasan V, MS, held the role of Organizing Secretary; and Dr. Nataraja Sethupathy, MS, was the Organizing Treasurer. The conference was organized under the leadership of senior surgeons, including Dr. S. Selvarajan and Dr. Selvam, as well as the collaborative efforts of all members of the local city branch.

A total of 214 delegates, including 118 postgraduate participants, attended the conference.

The conference program included a preliminary session for oral free papers, followed by a laparoscopic video session featuring presentations by Dr. J. Balamurugan from Thanjavur, Dr. S. Velmurugan from Trichy, Dr. R. Kumeran from Chennai, and Dr. J.A. Jayalal from Nagercoil. This was followed by a series of invited lectures on topics such as hereditary colon cancer by Dr. S. Marimuthu from Thanjavur, the basics and ergonomics of laparoscopy by Dr. U. Aravindan from Thanjavur, and a one-step approach to bile duct stones by Dr. K. Govindaraj from Trichy. The inauguration and guest speaker address featured Dr. C. Palanivel from Coimbatore discussing his innovations in minimal invasive surgery. In the afternoon, there was a panel discussion on the management of gastric cancer, moderated by Dr. S.G. Balamurugan from Madurai, as well as additional invited lectures on biomechanics in diabetic foot by Dr. Madhu Periyasamy from Coimbatore, fistula-in-ano radiology by Dr. J. Arunkumar from Kumbakonam, and surgical and medico-legal cases by Dr. M. Elangovan from Thanjavur. The program also included a panel discussion on urological emergencies, moderated by Dr. V. Praveen from Thanjavur, and postgraduate clinical case presentations on parotid swelling and locally advanced breast cancer.
